Minutes

- The meeting was called to order by Tim Harrell
- Review of Previous Minutes - Nicole Brown
 - ** NOW AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE**
 - The treasurer was reminded to open a new savings account for uniforms
- Treasurer's Report - Nicole Brown
 - Account balances as of 9/20/21
 - Total - \$35,251.18
 - Checking - \$12,020.81
 - Savings - \$14,428.00
 - Trip - \$8,802.37
- New/Current Business:
 - Trip
 - The second trip payment has been made to the tour company
 - Third payment is now due - statements will be going home with students Friday
 - Update
 - The hotel has not changed
 - If you cancel at this point, no refunds will be given as tickets are being purchased by the tour company
 - We will be eating at the Hard Rock Cafe instead of on the dinner boat as the menu was not going to be appropriate - we will still take the cruise

- We discussed safety - taking shifts in the hallways; we will talk more as we get closer to the trip
 - We still need \$6,000 for the busses - we are hoping to raise this between the Pancake Breakfast and the air fresheners
 - We discussed that there are a few students whose trips need to be sponsored - if anyone knows of someone willing to do this, please let us know
- Fundraisers:
 - We discussed the Pancake Breakfast to be held on December 10th
 - We will charge \$10 per ticket, children get to visit with Santa with the purchase of a ticket, digital photos will be available for \$5
 - We need donations of pancake mix, plates, napkins, cups, drinks, coffee, etc. ****walmart gift cards/cash**** - we will be making a post requesting donations/sponsors
 - The next fundraiser will be air fresheners in January
 - We've had several long trips this marching season and will possibly need the boosters to pay for some of the bus driver costs.
 - Kelly Legg made a motion for the boosters to pay up to \$500 towards bus driver costs. The motion was seconded by Latonia Wolfe. The motion passed.
 - We discussed having the BBQ dinner in early April.
 - We discussed having the Band Banquet in early April and asked to approve a budget of \$1,500. Ashley would like to get senior gifts ordered.
 - Latonia Wolfe made a motion to approve a \$1,500 budget for Band Banquet. The motion was seconded by Kelly Legg. The motion passed.

- We discussed the possibility of charging students some amount of money to attend Senior Clinic, All East, etc. We will discuss this further.
- Band camp for next year will look different. The plan is to have a “pre-camp” which will include all of the band (not just Percussion, Color Guard & Freshmen). This will not be all day like regular camp - more details to come.
 - Pre Camp dates - June 26-June 30
 - Full Band Camp dates - July 10-July 14
- The Christmas Concert will be December 8th at 7pm
- The Christmas parade will be December 3rd at 4pm
